COSTS

Food

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided for student participants. The approach to food provision will help students understand how our lifestyle choices impact the environment. Thinking far beyond the operational energy of building use, the programme will foster a big-picture understanding of energy. Food will be low embodied energy (considering packaging, air miles, and the food chain, inclusive to different dietary requirements, locally sourced where possible.

FOOD COSTS:

£30 PER STUDENT PER WEEK

Teaching

During the build, industry professionals will teach the students on 1 day of each week, based on the stage of the build. In addition, mentoring from a cost consultant and a carbon counting consultant throughout the build will address ubiquitous gaps in education. Students will learn about design team roles and experience collaborative working in practice.

TEACHING COSTS:

8 HOURS PER WEEK TEACHING: £50 PER HOUR

2 HOURS PER WEEK MENTORING COSTS: £100 PER HOUR

Shelter

Camp facilities will be completely off-grid. Supported by the programme coordinators, students will construct the camp structures during week 0 set-up, learning valuable skills that will translate to the main build. To be inclusive to students from different backgrounds separate male and female facilities will be provided.

Documentation

Our experience running student build projects has shown us the value of high quality documentation, undertaken by a professional film maker. COST BREAKDOWN

Student costs

- No Building As Usual will be run as a not for profit arm of Studio Bark. To make the programme possible, and to avoid discriminating students based on their ability to pay to attend, we are seeking sponsorship to cover the cost of each student.
- We are seeking student sponsorship from stakeholders with shared values from across the built environment sector
- The programme is for 10 students. The ten students will come from courses covering architecture, structural engineering, building services engineering, construction and cost consulting.
- The main build is 8 weeks, with 1 week set-up and 1 week contingency, totalling 10 weeks on site
